Actual funds available in all bank accounts 22/02/23 = \$1,490,677.00 which includes \$1,288,161.00 on term deposit @ varying interest rates and terms. Our large TD of 752,866 matures 17<sup>th</sup> April 2023, re investment on maturity for 6-12 months seems the best option depending on interest rates offered at the time.

## Revenue:

All revenue's in-line with 2022 which is a fantastic result considering the terrible weather we had throughout January 2023. Auckland anniversary weekend was a wash out, prior to this weekend we were up \$35k compared to last year. Cabin occupancy was 96.16% and camping sites were 87.98% down 5.88% on LY. The adverse weather cost us around \$50k in lost revenue this January.

## **Expenses**

Expenses only slightly up on last year by \$2,864 which again is a great result considering the inflationary pressures the camp has been put under. Financial admin up \$3,287 this is because we were invoiced for 3 months at once rather than monthly. Wages up \$6,279 due to staff increases. Security patrols down \$6,858 this is due to the security company being short staffed and unable to provide 2 guards per shift as previous years.
