110 solar panels on our facilities buildings

We installed solar panels in 2017, since then we've saved 26.5% of total power bill per year. We also have censor lights in all toilets and shower facilities, lights will automatically turn off when not in

We've reduced carbon usage by using electric vehicles (golf buggy's) for staff to move around the camp.

We support our local community by sponsoring the Waipu Cycleway. The goal is to have a full 9 km trail from Waipu Township to Waipu Cove with an exciting trail ride for cyclists and walkers. For more information, please visit www.waipucycleway.com.

Our dunes are really important to our community. It helps as natural defences against coastal hazards and erosion, while maintaining and enhancing the recreational opportunities of animal habitats. In 2017, Camp Waipu Cove was named the winner of 'New Zealand's Best Coastal Dune Restoration Project' by the Coastal Restoration Trust of New Zealand.



We reduced plastic by replacing the products in our cabins to paper-made and removed bin iner.
