### Safety Notes

- 5km speed limit at all times around the camp
- Please, no walking around the camp with an open alcoholic drink in your hand
- One car only per site, the yellow sticker given upon arrival must be displayed
- Campers must leave 3m between tent/caravan on own site and those on neighbouring sites. If you are not 1.5m from your marked boundary lines you will be asked to move.
- No gate access available between 10pm and 7am. You will need to park your vehicle at one of the car parks if returning after hours.
- NO open flame BBQ's, fires or fireworks at any time.
- All caravan's must have a current electrical WOF
